
















In Memory






Fatherhood Program: A Space for Him

We have been missing the male influence at The PCC for the past few months, but we are SO excited for the two new male "coaches" who will be re-launching our Fatherhood Program in the next few weeks. These two men have been training, seeking, and learning new things to be ready to come alongside as many dads as possible.

Along with these new coaches, the Fatherhood space has had a makeover! To be honest, it might be the most coveted space in the Center right now. We are grateful to have a space created with the dads we serve in mind, a space that is a welcoming, comfortable environment where they can connect, learn, and grow, a space designed to foster meaningful conversations, provide resources, and offer support for dads as they navigate the important role of fatherhood. We can't wait to see how this refreshed space will impact the lives of the fathers we serve!

Sometimes, a client remains on the hearts of the staff at The Pregnancy Care Center long after her time there has ended. One particular client came to The PCC about two years ago, overwhelmed by an unplanned pregnancy. She was consumed with fear and anxiety after seeing the positive test and was unsure what to do. During her visit, she struggled with the three options before her, often in tears. Though undecided, she returned for a second ultrasound and further counseling. Having a relationship with Jesus, her convictions ran deep, but after her last appointment, communication stopped.

For two years, a mentor at The PCC passed by the client's workplace on her way to work, praying that God would meet her where she was and reveal His love. One day, the mentor was called in to the Center unexpectedly and, upon arriving, saw two young women in the waiting room. To her surprise, one of them was the very client she had been praying for. The two embraced, and the client shared that the love, compassion, and lack of judgment she experienced at The PCC led her to bring her sister, who was now facing an unplanned pregnancy.

Though the client had chosen abortion two years earlier, they were able to talk about The PCC's Post-Abortion Care and the unchanging love of Jesus. Her sister, after receiving support, decided to choose life for her baby and signed up for our Countdown to Parenthood program. She even asked her sister—the former client—to be her support person and come to each appointment with her.

This story beautifully shows how clients feel loved and safe returning to The PCC, regardless of their past. It also serves as a reminder that the prayers lifted on behalf of each person who enters the Center's doors are heard, and God remains faithful in His work.
