Showing support for the unborn can come in many different forms, and for a local college student, she's expressing her pro-life passion on her bicycle! Megan is a local "Biking for Babies" missionary who is embarking on a journey to raise money and awareness for The PCC of Rockford. "Hello!!! My name is Megan Sardegna. I am a second year Biking for Babies missionary. Just like last year, I am riding on the Wisconsin Team! I am thrilled to be coming back this year because I believe that all humans, from conception to natural death, should be loved, respected, and cared for. Last year, I experienced that love, respect, and care from my fellow Biking for Babies missionaries and from the pregnancy resource center (PRC) that I was partnered with.

Last year, I was welcomed to Biking for Babies with open arms. Throughout the missionary formation process, I was constantly told 'You are not alone,' and I constantly felt supported. On the National Ride, I was taken care of from sunup to sundown by my amazing Support Crew. The moment I walked into the PRC I was partnered with, I was met with smiles, hugs, and love. Immediately, they asked me how they could help me. I am returning this year to raise funds for the PRCs across the US to make sure that they can continue to meet every person who walks through their doors with the love and care that I experienced. In the midst of abortion access returning to our city, the Lord has encouraged me greatly by many young people in our community who are taking a stand for life. You hopefully read about Megan and her Biking for Babies ministry, and I have recently connected with an excited group of students who attend Rock Valley College and are working hard to launch an official Students for Life club on their campus. We also have a Student Advisory Board here at The PCC, and we will be taking new applications in August for a new year of service beginning in September. If you know a student 15–20 years old who would like to learn more about this opportunity, please have them reach out this summer to learn more.

We serve a God who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think (Eph. 3:20). He is faithful and we can stand firm knowing that He came that we may have life and have it abundantly (John 10:10). #### **Holding On To Life**

16-year-old \*Zara came to The PCC with her boyfriend at the end of March. She shared that though she had recently had an abortion, she was pregnant again. Her mom had pushed her to have the abortion for her previous pregnancy, but also gave her a Bible and books on sin. This left her very confused. Finding herself pregnant again, she leaned towards keeping the baby and parenting, but also opened up about being in a very vulnerable state and unsure what she could handle, and she was afraid to tell her family about the pregnancy.

Zara scheduled a follow-up appointment at The PCC but kept canceling and rescheduling. Weeks went by, and we didn't think we would get the chance to offer her the help and hope she desperately needed, but at the end of May, she showed up to her ultrasound appointment with Sheila. Zara's boyfriend didn't attend the appointment with her, so one of our volunteers, Judy, sat in with her. The ultrasound showed a healthy and growing 15-week old baby.

After the ultrasound, Zara, Sheila, and Judy were talking about Zara's previous abortion. She said she didn't think it affected her, until she saw the baby. She pulled out her phone and showed Sheila and Judy a picture of a perfectly formed 10-week-old baby in the palm of her hand. You could see a perfect little face, little hands and feet on his long arms and legs, and you could see that he was a boy. She told Sheila and Judy that "she didn't know." She didn't know she would see a baby; she didn't know she could already know the gender; she didn't know what the abortion was really going to do to her.

Zara shared that she started to read her Bible daily, and it is bringing her great comfort, and she realized that it was time for her to be responsible. She couldn't just keep getting an abortion and living life the way she had been. Though she and her boyfriend haven't told their parents yet, they are determined to show up and take responsibility. They have chosen to carry and parent the little life that is currently growing inside Zara, and are excited to have The PCC walking alongside them through our Countdown to Parenthood program.

One God-ordained detail in this story is Judy being the mentor to be in that ultrasound room with Zara. Judy is one of our mentors who offers Post-Abortion Care, which is a safe, confidential, and non-judgmental place where women can express their emotions and find healing and restoration from a past abortion. Judy was able to tell Zara about this service and as she mentors Zara and her boyfriend on parenting and all things related, she will also get to walk Zara through the Post-Abortion Care program.

Zara made a very brave decision to choose life for her baby while still going to school and trying to work. She is carrying the weight of the world on her shoulders as she prepares for this new life, while simultaneously processing the loss of the baby boy she aborted. But as Zara will learn as she continues to read her Bible and learn about Jesus, and as she is poured into by Judy during her visits, no matter what her past is, she can find redemption through His blood and freedom from the weight of her sin. She can find not only help and hope for her current circumstances, but an eternal hope. She can find healing.
